When you want to use a large false ceiling, one may use a chandelier and a gold leaf on the ceilings. One may also use luxury carpets to add lot of color to the room. One may also hang any luxury painting to give a majestic touch to your room. If you have a budget issue, there are lot of affordable paintings today available in the market.”
